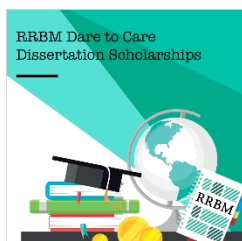

KEY DETAILS:

- **What:** Dare to Care Dissertation Scholars Award (Up to ten students will be awarded financial support up to \$10,000 USD and intellectual support from the RRBM community, according to need)
- **When:** Applications accepted November 1-30, 2022
- **Who:** Doctoral Students in Business Schools whose research aligns with the [Principles of Responsible Research](#) and focuses on social justice within organizations, thereby contributing to meeting one or more of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals.
- **Requirements:** Proposal describing dissertation research and alignment with scholarship criteria; completed online reference forms from two individuals (including thesis advisor); curriculum vita.
- **Recommended:** Participation in Philosophical Foundations of Responsible Research course, offered virtually September 2022 through November 2022.

Up to ten scholarships of up to \$10,000 each will be awarded to doctoral students in business schools who are conducting dissertation research aligned with the principles of responsible research (www.rrbm.network). Award winners also receive intellectual support from within the community of RRBM Scholars according to need.

Eligible research topics will focus on economic inequality, racial, gender or other forms of social justice in organizations, thereby contributing to meeting one or more of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals.

The Dare to Care Dissertation Scholarship recognizes the importance of young scholars and their mentors to the pursuit of credible and useful research in the business and management disciplines.

Interested candidates are encouraged to discuss the opportunity with their thesis advisor. The eligible applicant is a doctoral candidate at the beginning stage of the dissertation research; is

studying in a business school in any of the disciplines as long as the research falls within the domain described above; and demonstrates a commitment to the RRBM Principles of Responsible Research. Candidates are highly encouraged to participate in a Philosophical Foundations of Responsible Research course, offered virtually September to mid-November 2022.

Applications will be accepted November 1-30, 2022. Award decisions will be announced March 1, 2023.
